
**Summary:** This project is for the purchase and clearing of land near Gardner airport to secure air rights and preserve approach slope near the runway.






## 2025-090-NWKRPC City of Hays

- 69-mile long, 24" water supply pipeline from R-9 ranch in Edwards County to Hays.
- Eventually route to Russell in separate project.
- Long-term water supply.
- Long history of water conservation in region.
- Sustainability of water supply through conservation of water.

**BIL Program:** DOT | Airport Infrastructure Grants (AIG) Program

Project Name: Airport Infrastructure Grants (AIG) Program

Federally Required Match: 10% of total project cost

Due Date: September 30, 2025

**Summary:** This project is for improvements to runway, taxiway, lighting, signage, and electrical infrastructure at Hugoton Municipal Airport.

Total Project Costs:	\$364,980	100%



Due Date: April 1, 2025


**Summary:** This project is to install two storm sirens to enhance severe weather alert coverage, improve public safety, and ensure all city residents receive timely emergency warnings.

- Current coverage is theoretical; not performing due to trees, terrain, and buildings in populated areas.
- New sirens will compensate for lost coverage areas.

- Add second treatment train to South Plant
- North Plant seasonal use only.
- Provide redundancy and reliability

- Released in February




