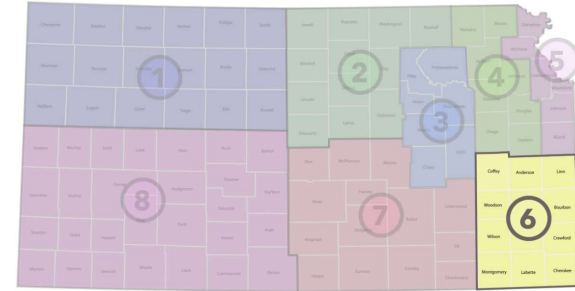

**Summary:** This project is for upgrades to metering of an entire water system and improvements at two water treatment plants.

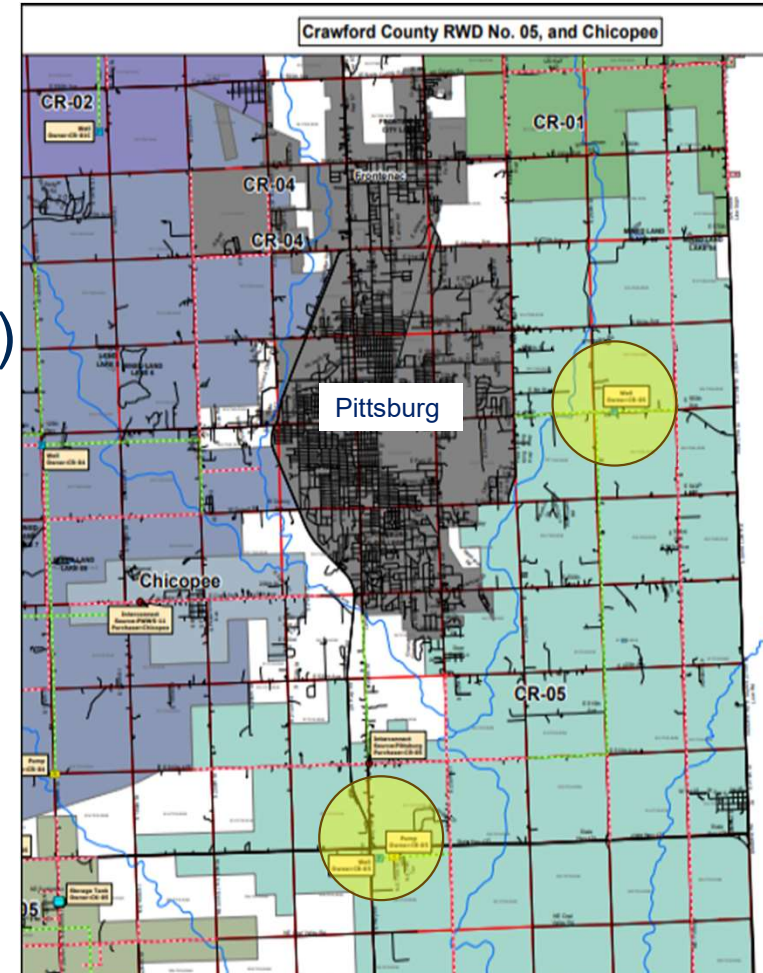

Image 1B: Damaged Supply Line in the North Plant

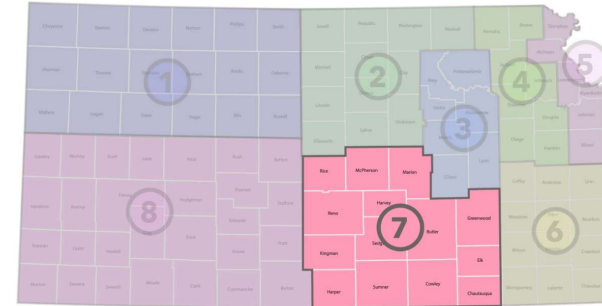


Image 2B: Corrosive Damage in Filter at North Plant

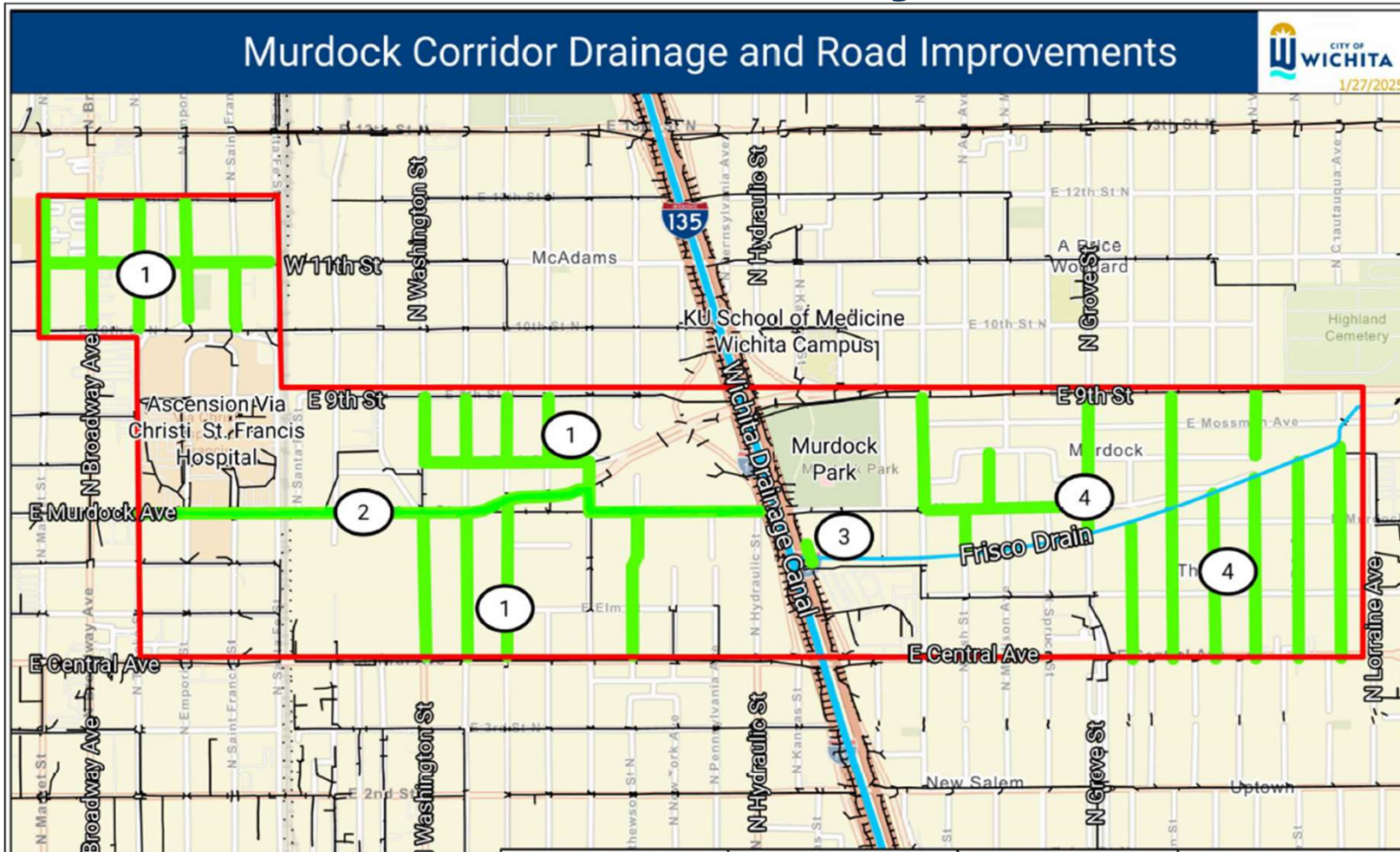

**Summary:** This project is to mitigate street flooding and reduce floodplain size through storm sewer upgrades and street reconstruction.

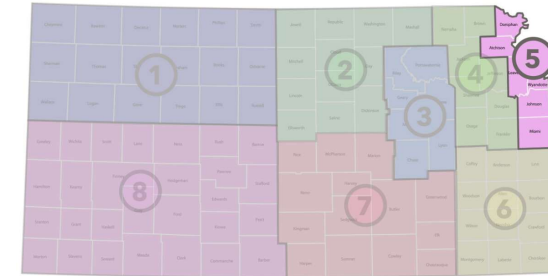

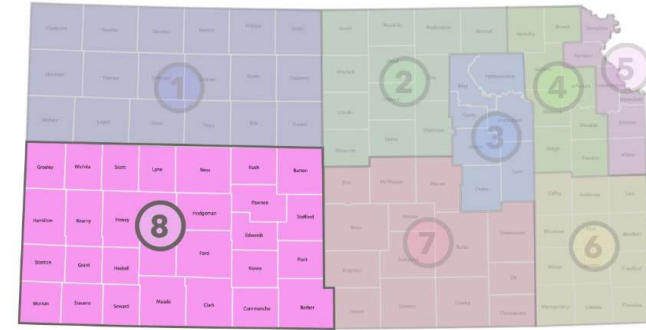
# 2025-090-NWKRPC

## City of Hays

- 69-mile long, 24" water supply pipeline from R-9 ranch in Edwards County to Hays.
- Eventually route to Russell in separate project.
- Long-term water supply.
- Long history of water conservation in region.
- Sustainability of water supply through conservation of water.

**Due Date:** September 30, 2025

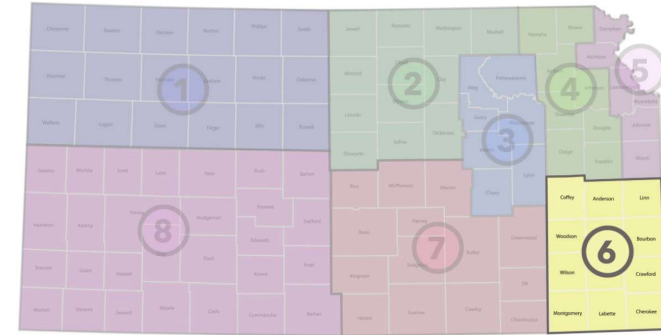
**Summary:** This project is for improvements to runway, taxiway, lighting, signage, and electrical infrastructure at Hugoton Municipal Airport.

<b>BKF Request Amount:</b>	<b>\$18,249</b>	<b>5%</b>
<b>Local Contribution (Cash):</b>	\$18,249	5%
<b>Federal Funding Unlocked</b>	\$328,482	90%
<b>Total Project Costs:</b>	<b>\$364,980</b>	<b>100%</b>

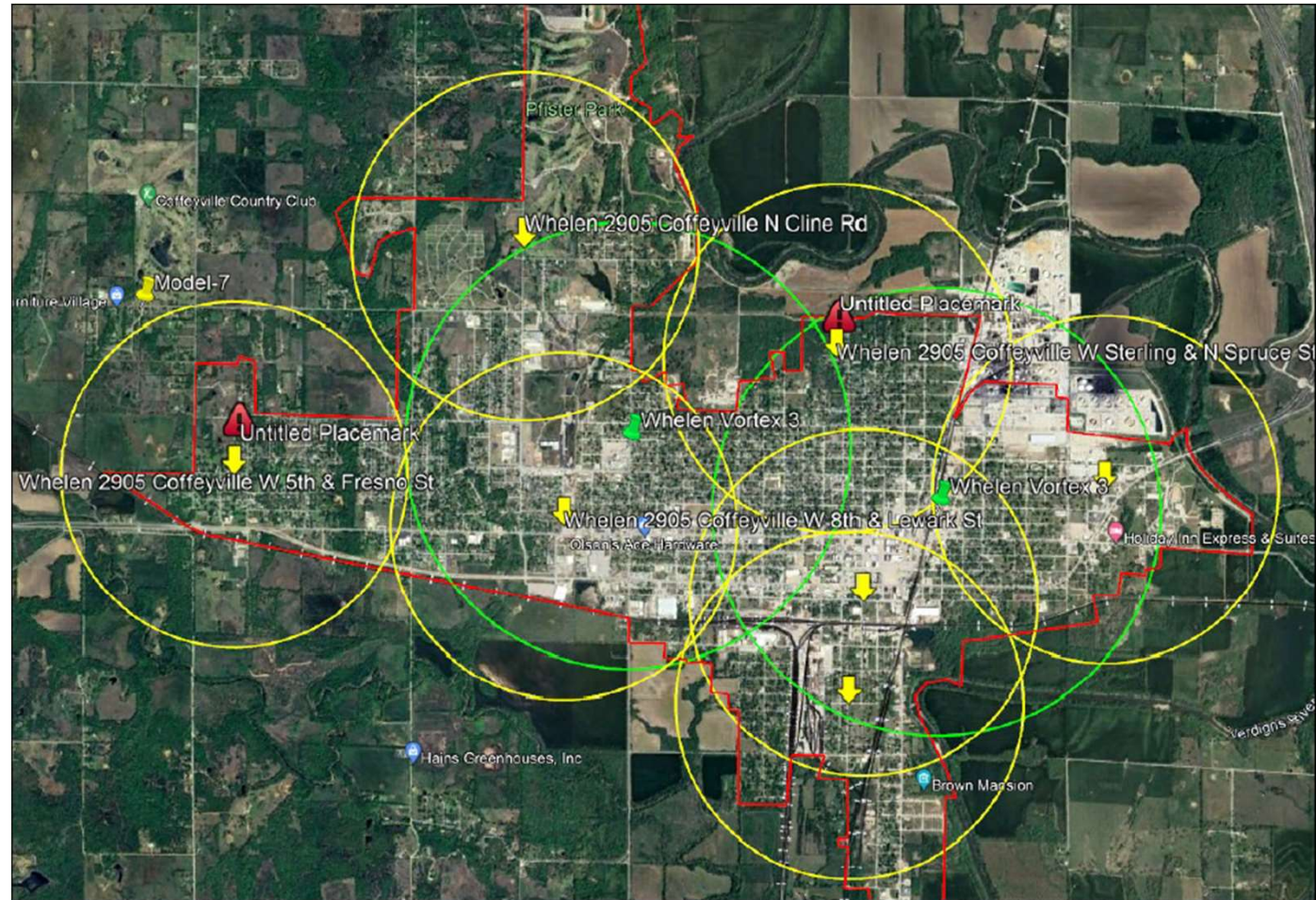

**Summary:** This project is to install two storm sirens to enhance severe weather alert coverage, improve public safety, and ensure all city residents receive timely emergency warnings.

<b>BKF Request Amount:</b>	<b>\$9,053</b>	<b>15%</b>
<b>Local Contribution (Cash):</b>	\$6,035	10%
<b>Federal Funding Unlocked</b>	\$45,264	75%
<b>Total Project Costs:</b>	<b>\$60,352</b>	<b>100%</b>

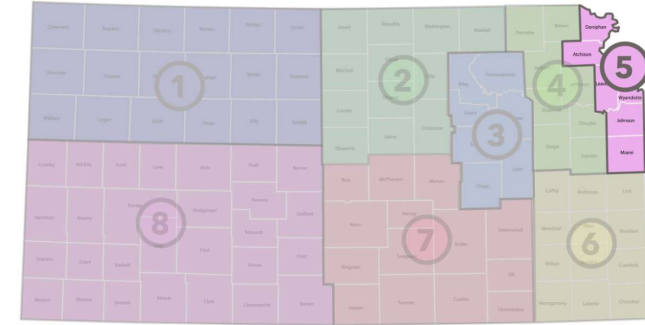
# 2025-094-SEKRPC – City of Coffeyville

- Current coverage is theoretical; not performing due to trees, terrain, and buildings in populated areas.
- New sirens will compensate for lost coverage areas.

**Project Name:** Leavenworth Waterworks Board South Treatment Plant Resiliency Project

**Federally Required Match:** 25% of total project cost

**Due Date:** April 1, 2025

**Summary:** The project is to add a full second treatment train to Leavenworth Water Works' South Treatment Plant.

<b>BKF Request Amount:</b>	<b>\$11,328,750</b>	<b>24%</b>
<b>Local Contribution (Cash):</b>	\$596,250	1%
<b>Federal Funding Unlocked</b>	\$35,775,000	75%
<b>Total Project Costs:</b>	<b>\$47,700,000</b>	<b>100%</b>

- Provide redundancy and reliability

- Released in February

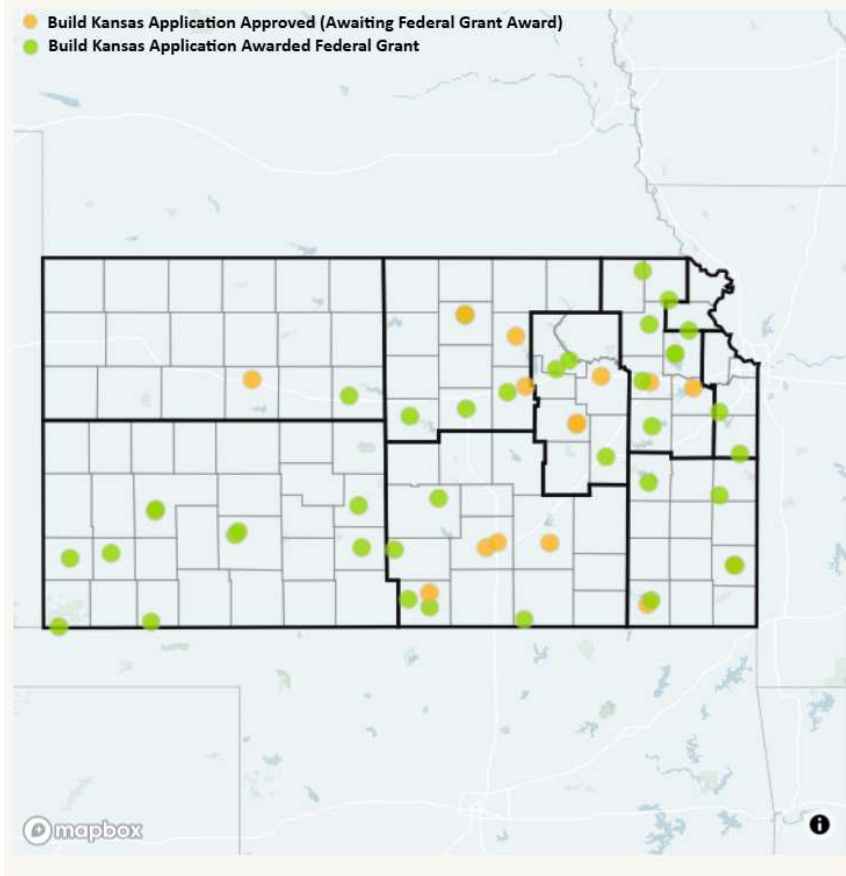
- **Hub Webinar Series**

- Held 1st Wednesday of the month.

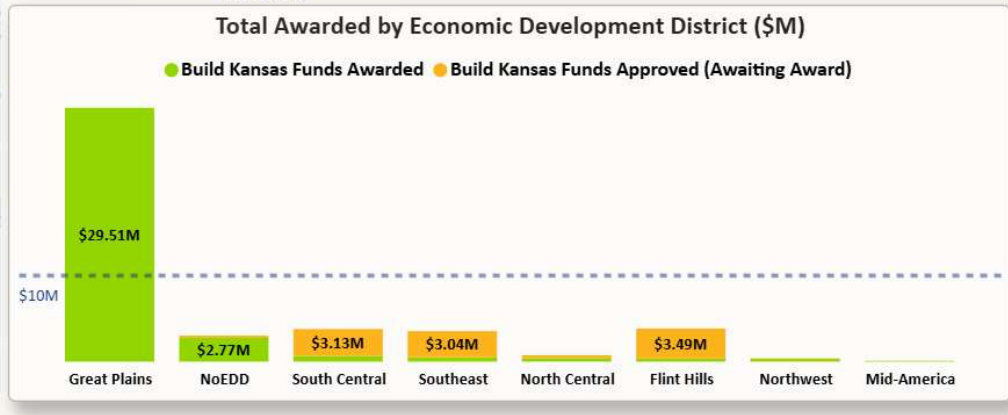

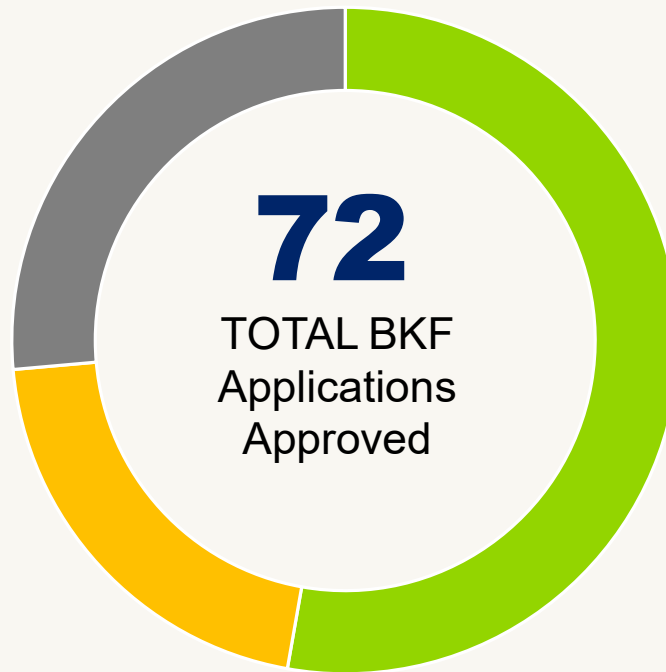

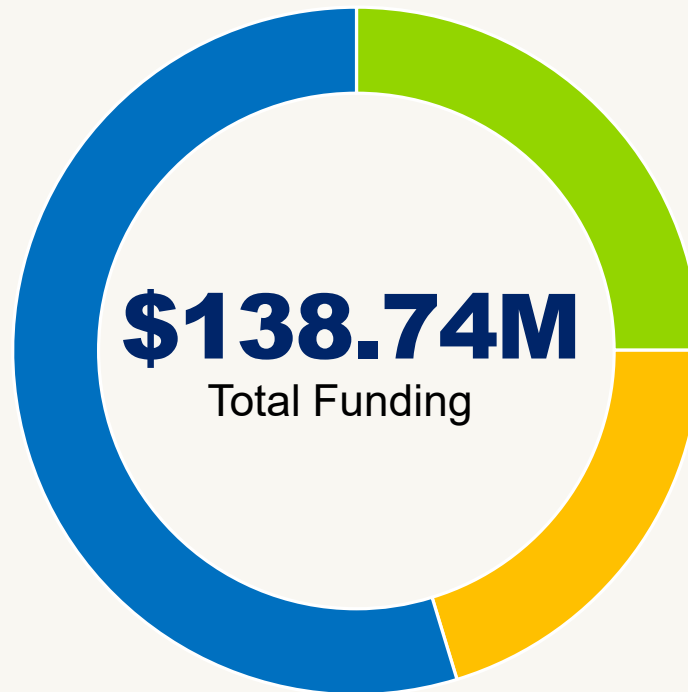
