



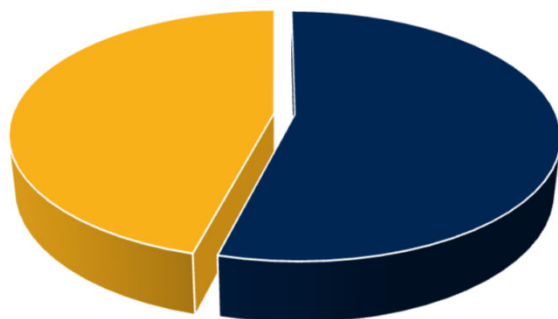

BIL Overview

- Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL)
 - AKA Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA)
- National Infrastructure Investment = \$1.2 Trillion across 5 years
 - Nearly 400 programs across 12 Federal Agencies
 - 60% Formula / 40% Discretionary

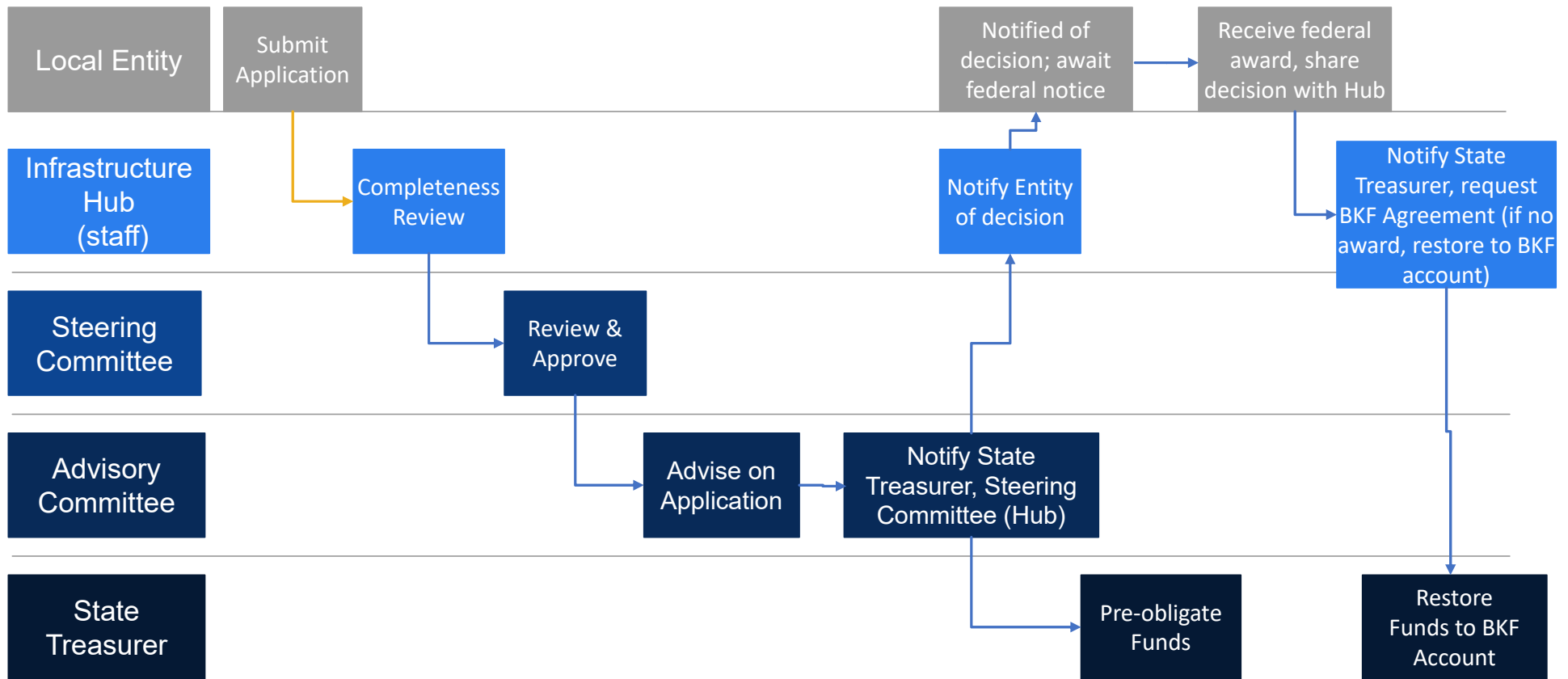

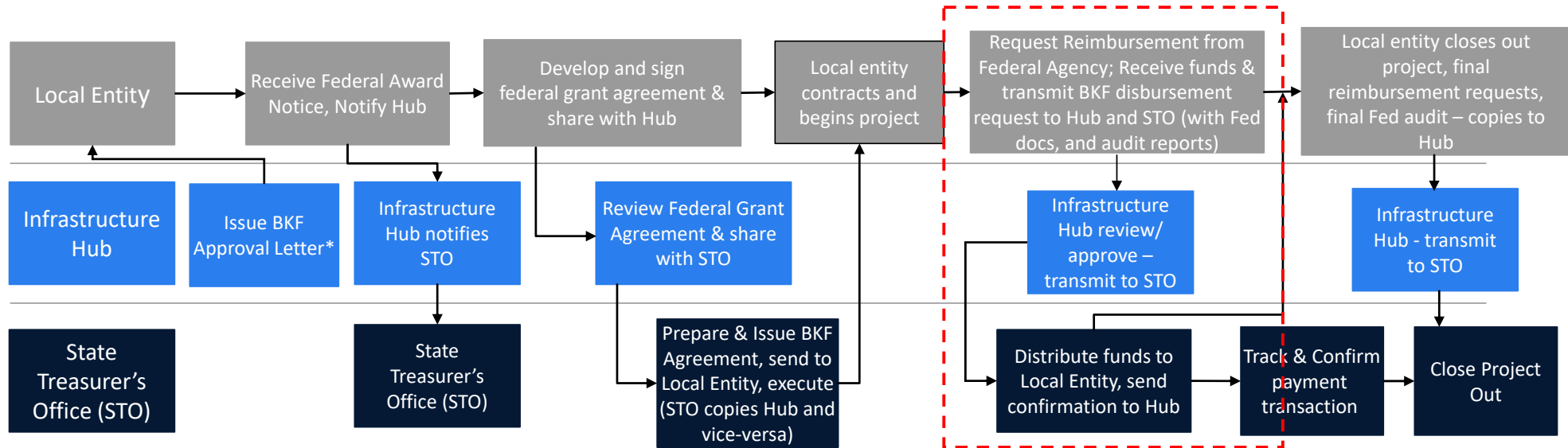

Build Kansas Fund | STO Reimbursement Process

**Note – this process begins after the BKF Application is approved by Steering Committee and Advisory Committee*



Key Assumptions: Federal program is reimbursement based; BKF will be distributed after federal reimbursement is made and appropriate documentation is provided; Oversight and compliance is performed by federal funding agency and expected to satisfy BKF needs; Distribution of funds will occur in a cadence defined by federal award.

Important Notes

Eligible entities should submit their Build Kansas Fund application while their federal BIL program application is still in progress

Federal BIL program award notification timelines unknown

Build Kansas funds are contingent upon federal BIL program award notice

Important notes

- The Hub is **not** selecting projects
 - The Hub serves in an advisory capacity
- Projects only receive Build Kansas Funds **if awarded** a federal grant
 - Federal agencies make project selections and provide award notification
- **This is additive only**
 - Communities can apply without requesting Technical Assistance OR making a Build Kansas Fund Application

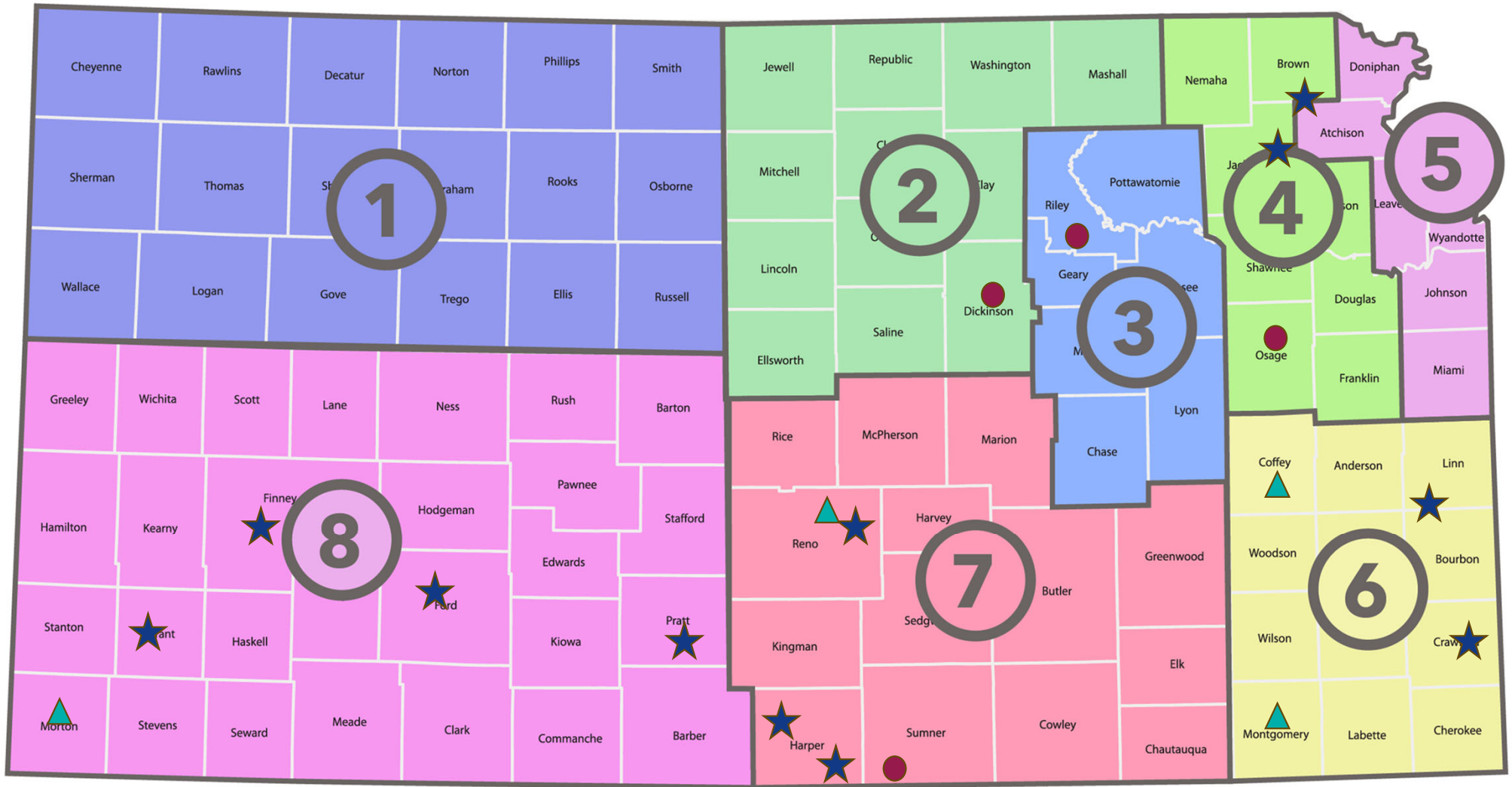

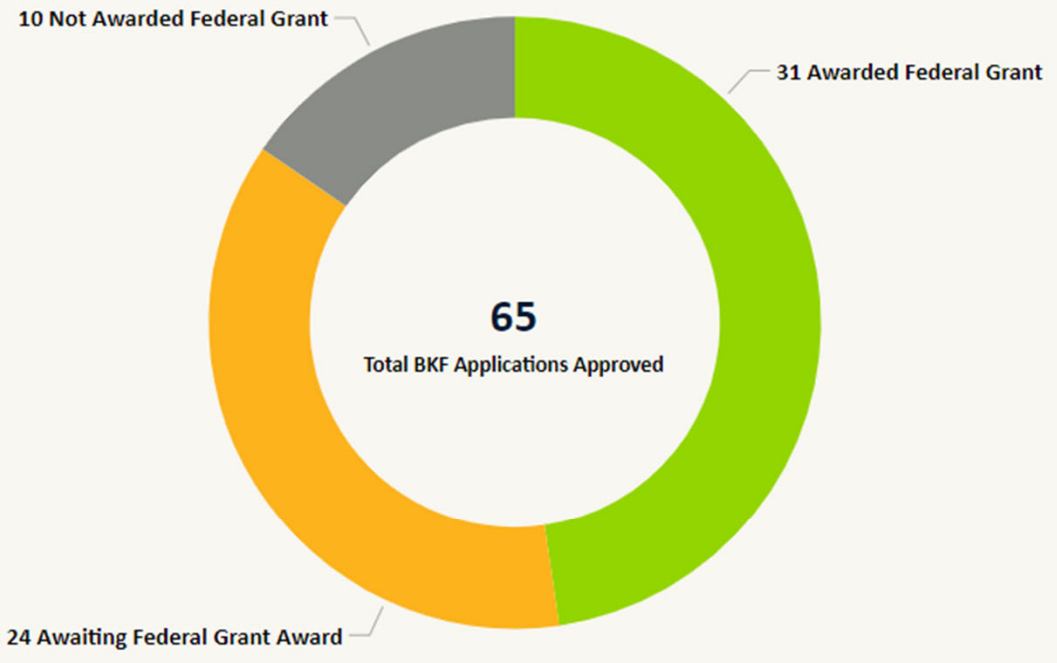

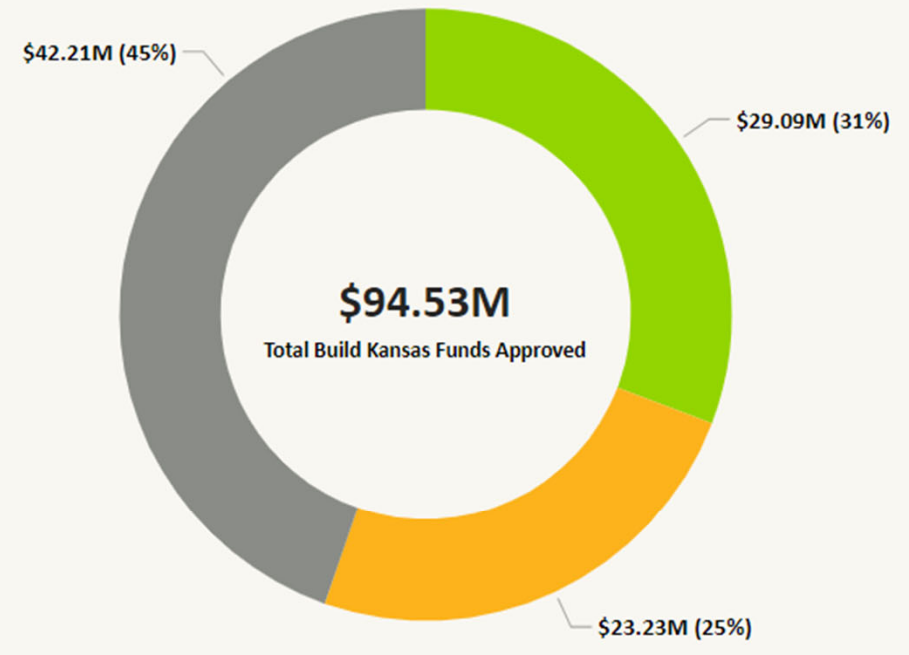


Status of Build Kansas Fund Applications



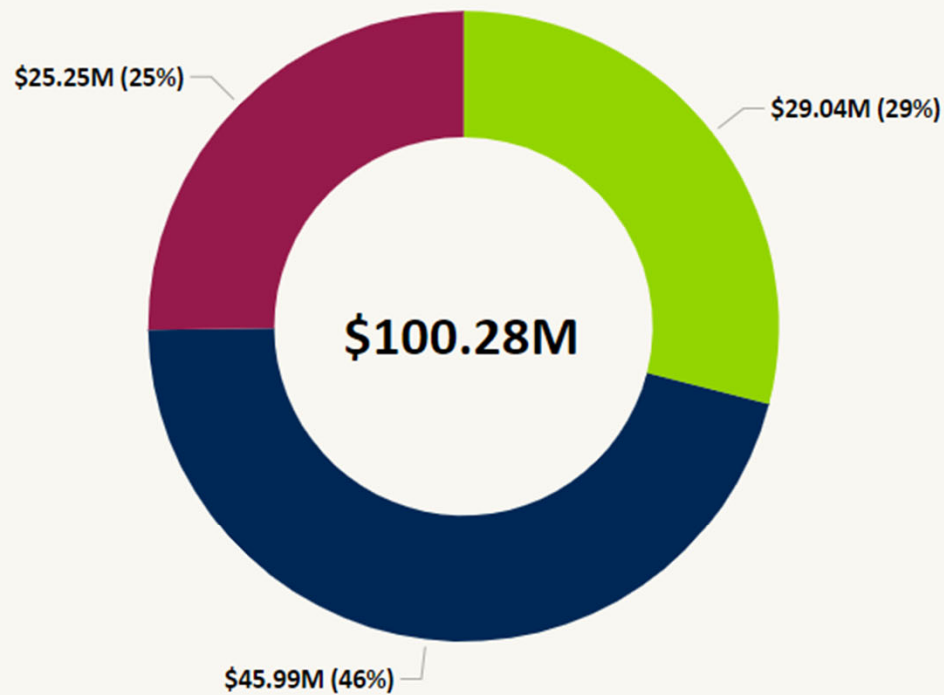

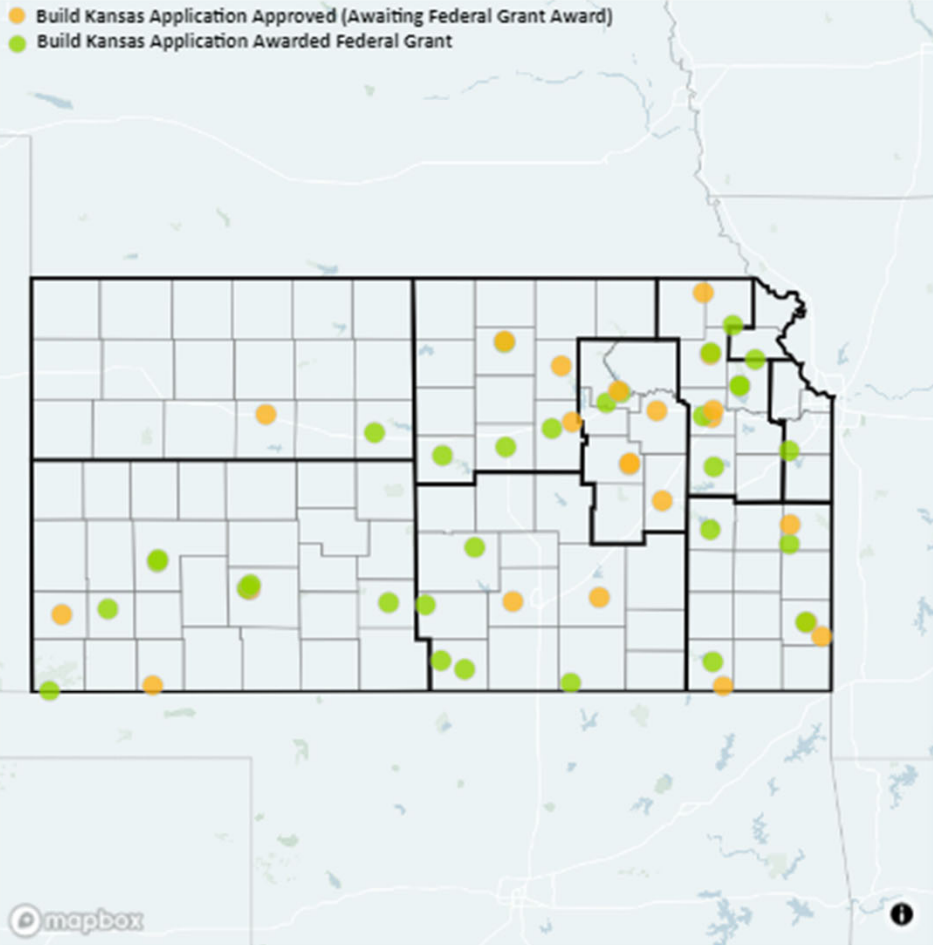

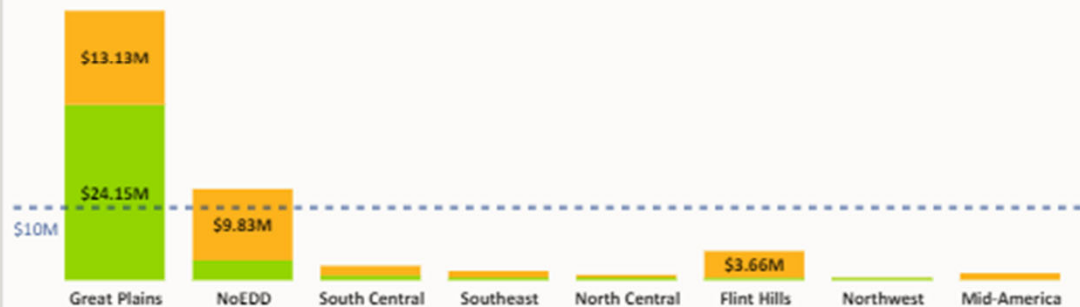

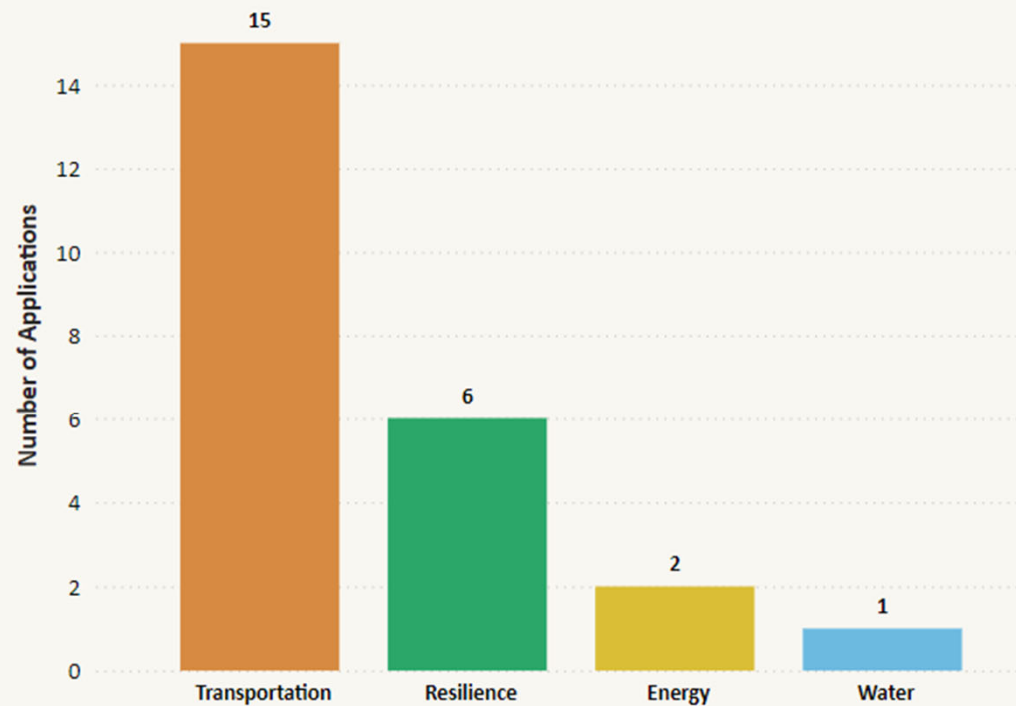
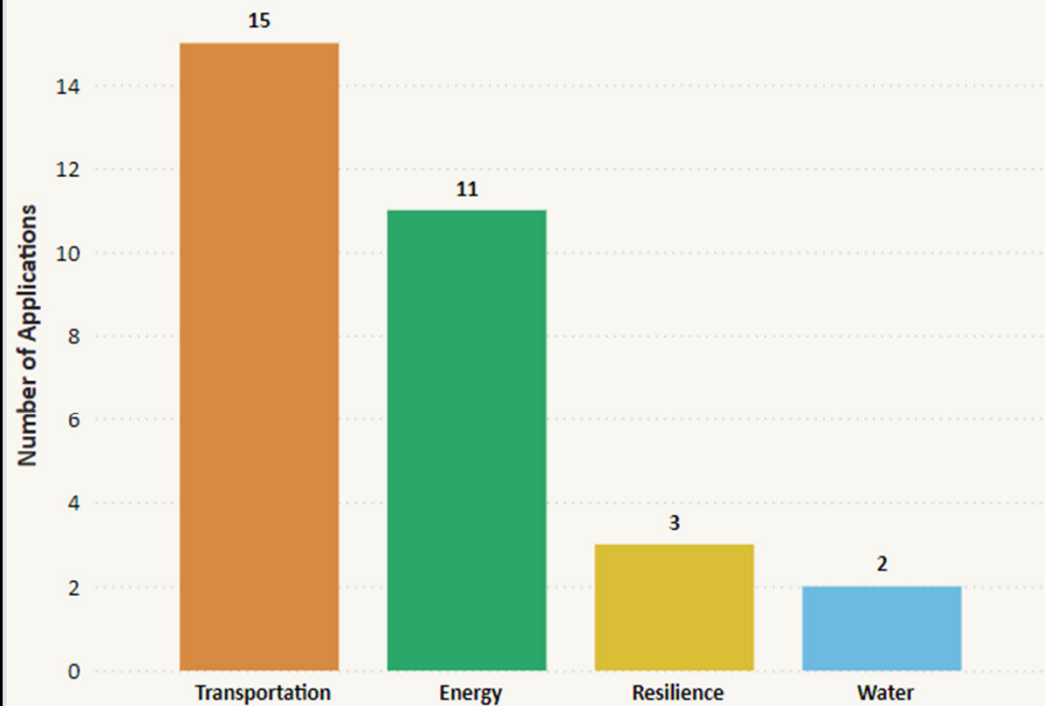

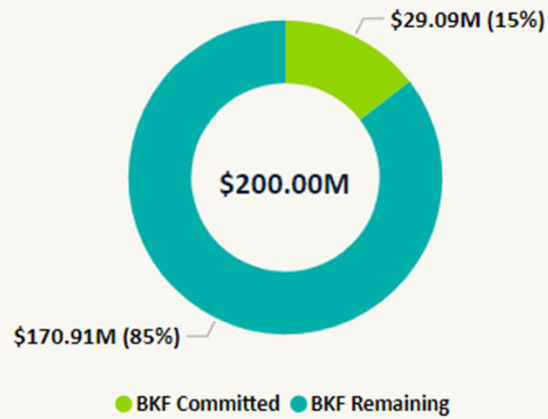

Applications Awarded Federal Grant By Infrastructure Sector

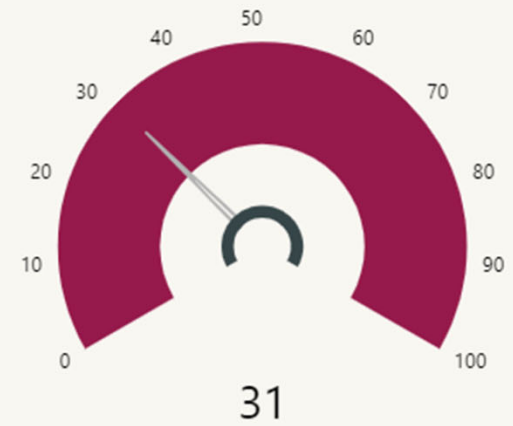
Applications Awaiting Federal Grant Award By Infrastructure Sector



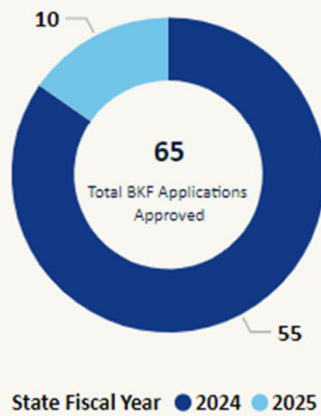

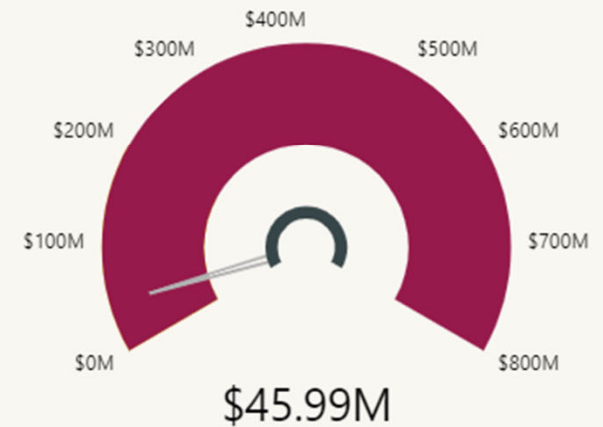
Count of Federal Awards

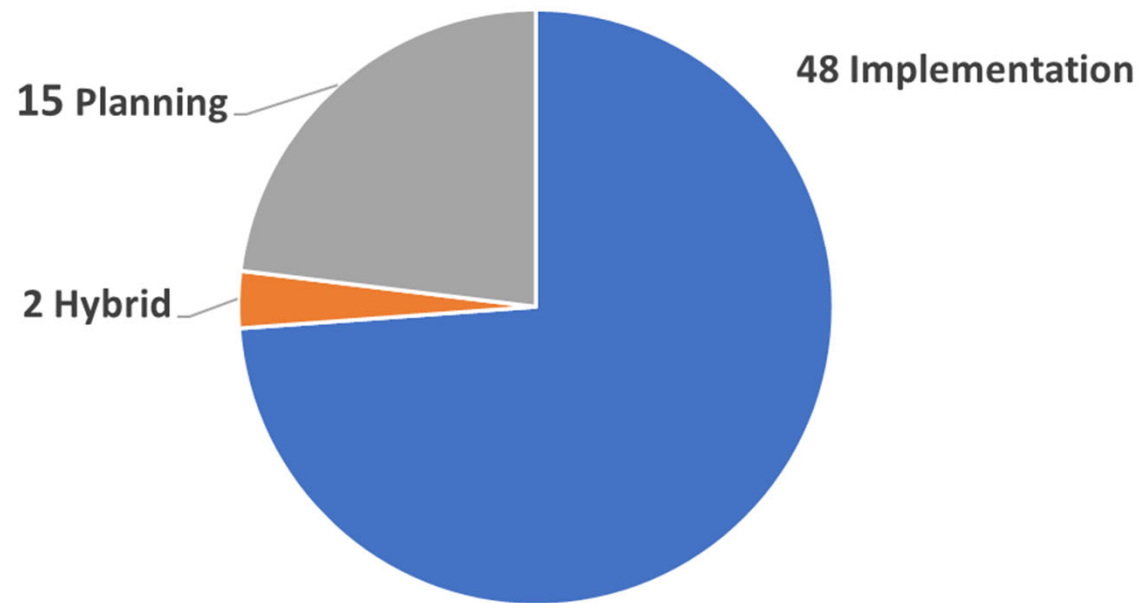

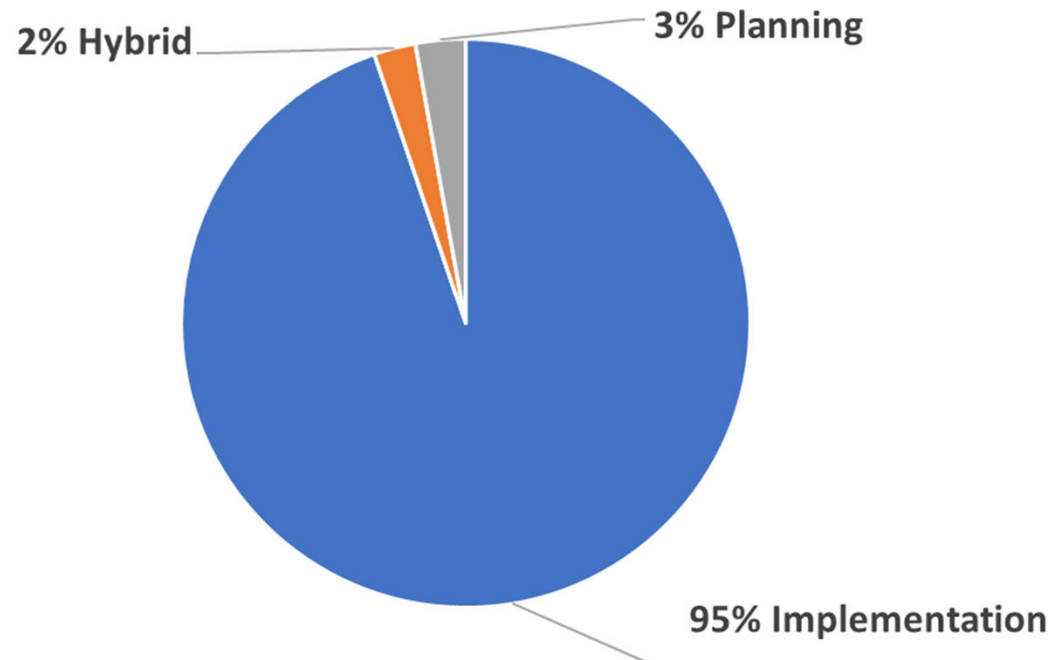
Funding of Implementation and Planning Projects by BKF

Build Kansas Fund – Project Types by Number

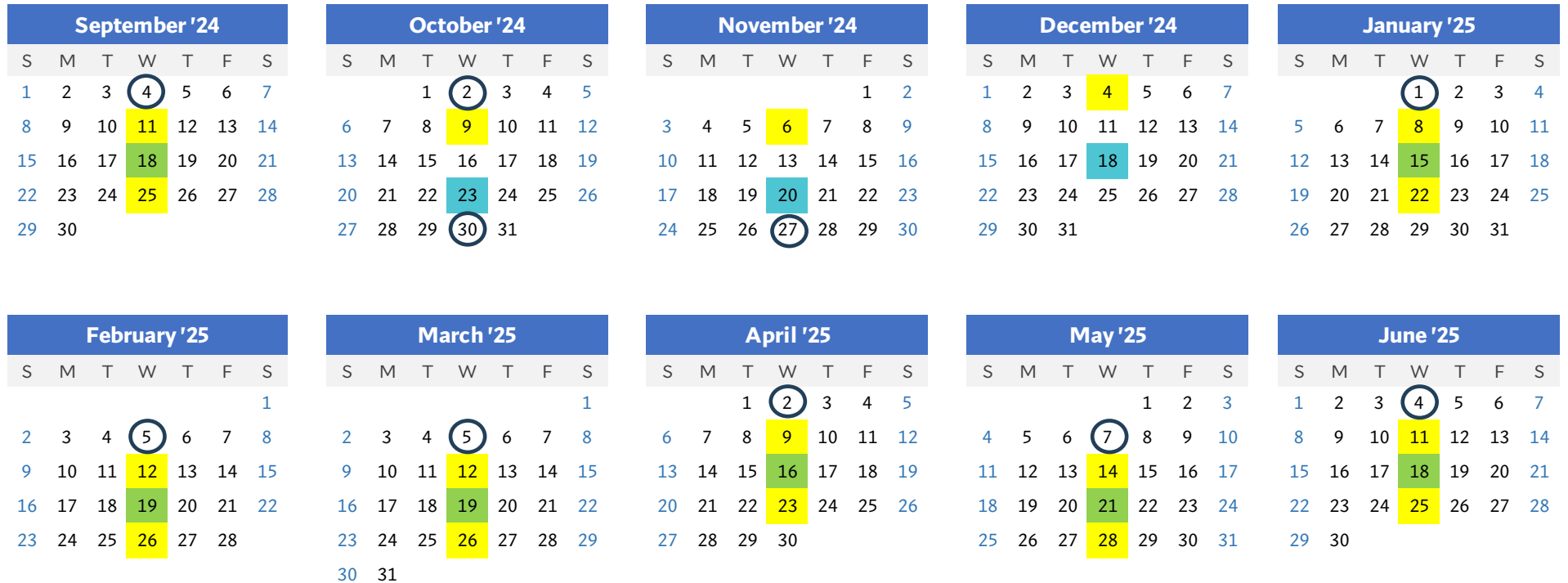


Funding of Implementation and Planning Projects by BKF

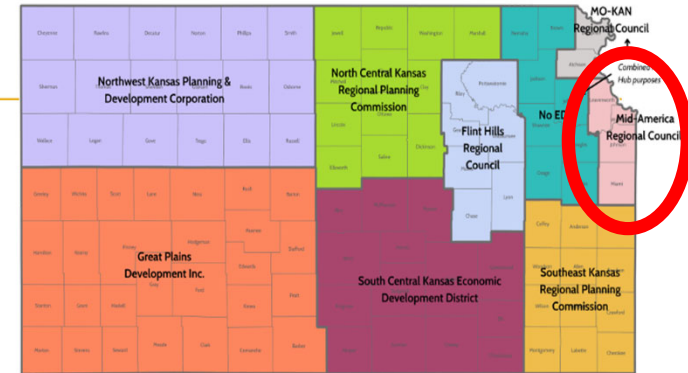

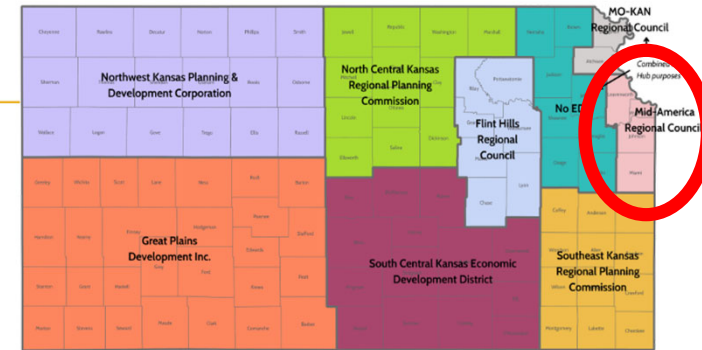

Summary: This project is for surface treatment for runway 3/21, turnaround connector taxiway, and apron rehabilitation asphalt overlay.



2025-078-GPDA : Port Authority of Stafford County (PASC)

BIL Program: DOT | RAISE (Round 1)

Project Name: Central Kansas Transload Facility

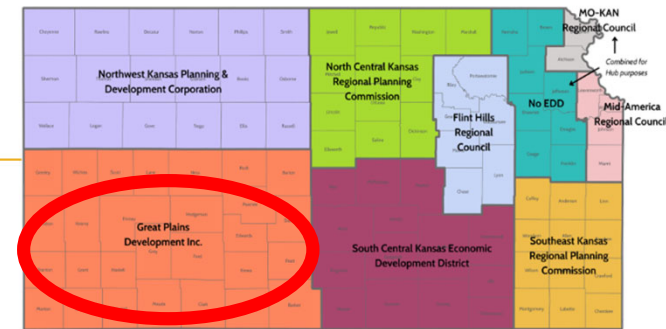
Federally Required Match: 20% of total project cost/ 0% for Rural designation

BKF Request Amount: \$5,000,000.00 (15.39% of total project cost) *

Local Contribution: \$2,500,000.00 (7.69% of total project cost)

Federal Funding Unlocked: \$25,000,000.00 (76.92% of total project cost)

Total Project Cost: \$32,500,000.00



Summary: The project is to develop a rail-served transload facility and grain terminal adjacent to BNSF Railways (BNSF) La Junta subdivision.

*PASC applied to BKF for same grant and project in early 2024, were approved for BKF, but not awarded a federal grant. However, they received a Project of Merit designation. Per the FY2025 RAISE NOFO, Projects of Merit are allowed to resubmit their previous year's application, with no changes, for consideration again this year. PASC is going to resubmit per that program designation.

BIL Program: BOR | WaterSMART: Water & Energy Efficiency
Project Name: HPCO – SMART Metering Energy Efficiency
& Water Conservation Initiative

Federally Required Match: 50% of total project cost

BKF Request Amount: \$1,086,465.67 (47.5% of total project cost)

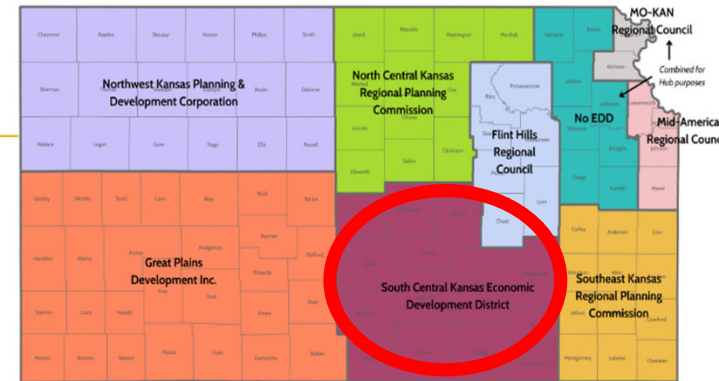
Local Contribution: \$57,182.40 (2.5% of total project cost) *

Federal Funding Unlocked: \$1,143,648.07 (50% of total project cost)

Total Project Cost: \$2,287,296.14

* Due to the regional nature of this project the applicant is not required to provide local match, but that is their desire.

Summary: This project is to replace 2,240 water and 2,668 electric meters with upgraded meters, and associated hardware and software.
