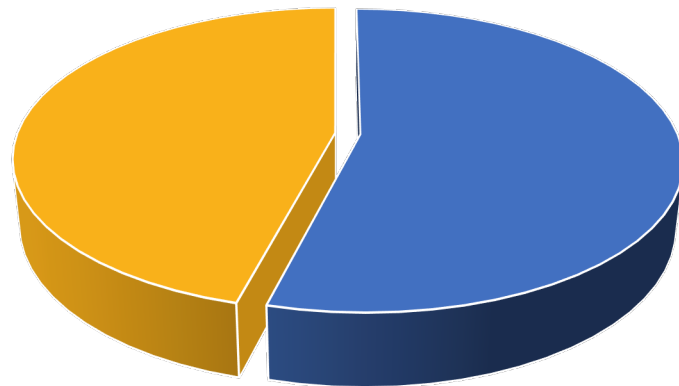

- Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL)
  - AKA Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA)
- National Infrastructure Investment = \$1.2 Trillion across 5 years
  - Nearly 400 programs across 12 Federal Agencies
  - 60% Formula / 40% Discretionary

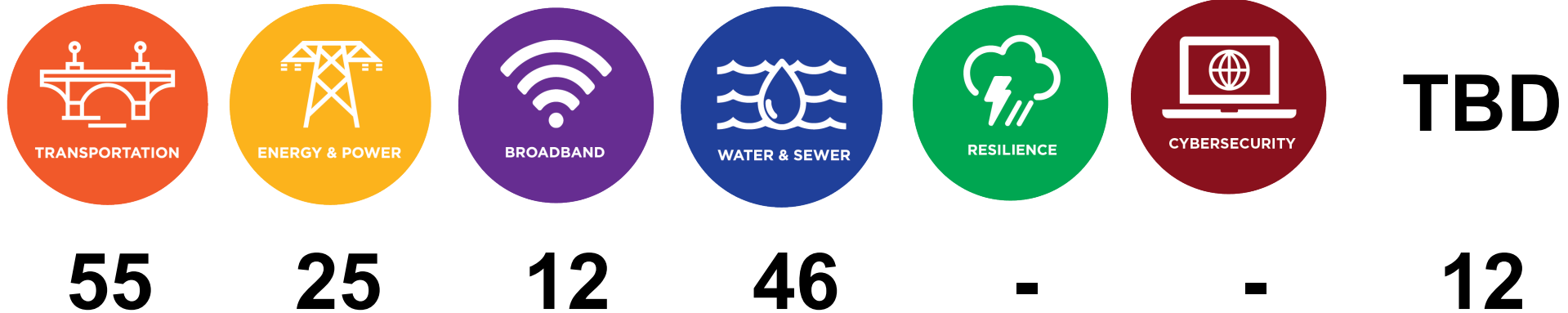

## Match Support

- Average local match requirements for most BIL programs is 20%
- Potentially, if we invest \$200 million as the local match for projects that could return as much as **\$800 million** to Kansas for infrastructure projects.

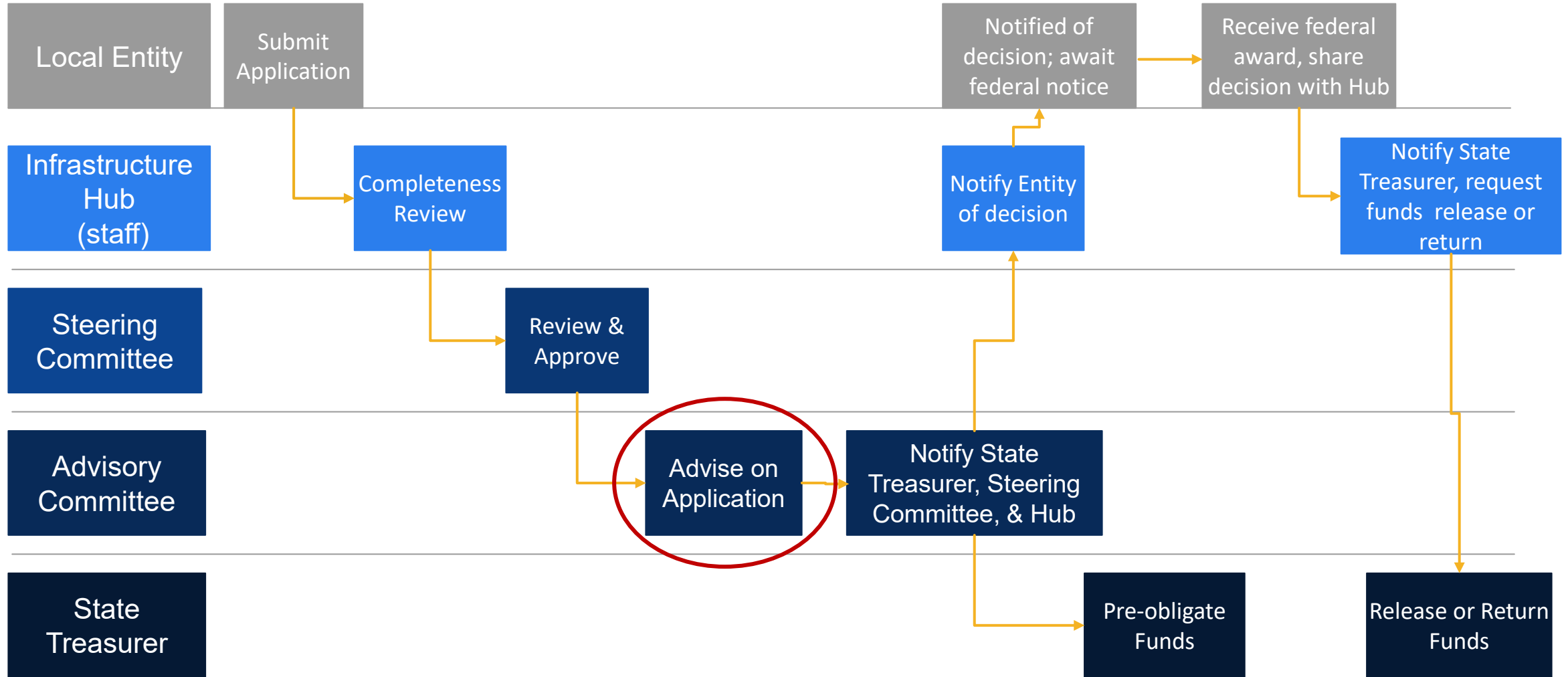
# BIL Grant & Build Kansas Fund Application Process Overview



# Important notes

- The Hub is not selecting projects.
- Projects only receive funds if awarded a federal grant. Federal agencies make those selections.
- **This is additive only.** Communities can apply for federal grants without going through the Hub.

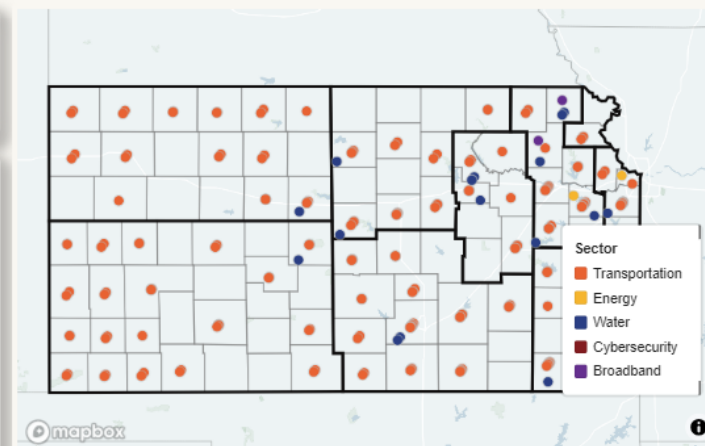

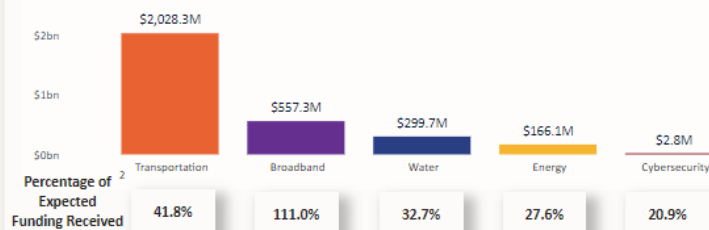

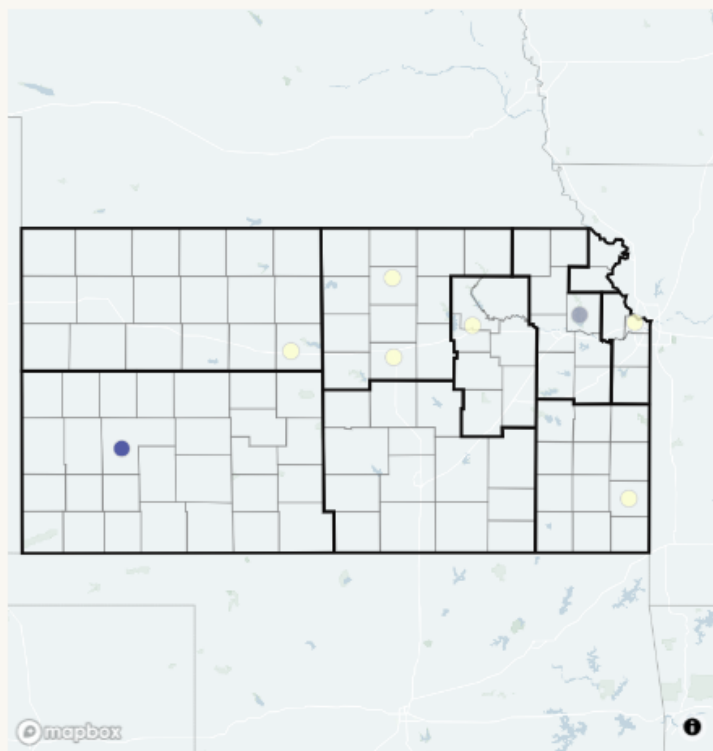

**BKF Applications Approved**- An application is approved upon review and recommendation for approval by the Steering Committee and Legislative Advisory Committee. Official award of Build Kansas funds is contingent on whether the applicant is awarded and formally accepts the federal BIL grant award.

**BKF Applications Awarded** - A Build Kansas Fund application is officially awarded funds when the entity is awarded and formally accepts the federal BIL grant award.

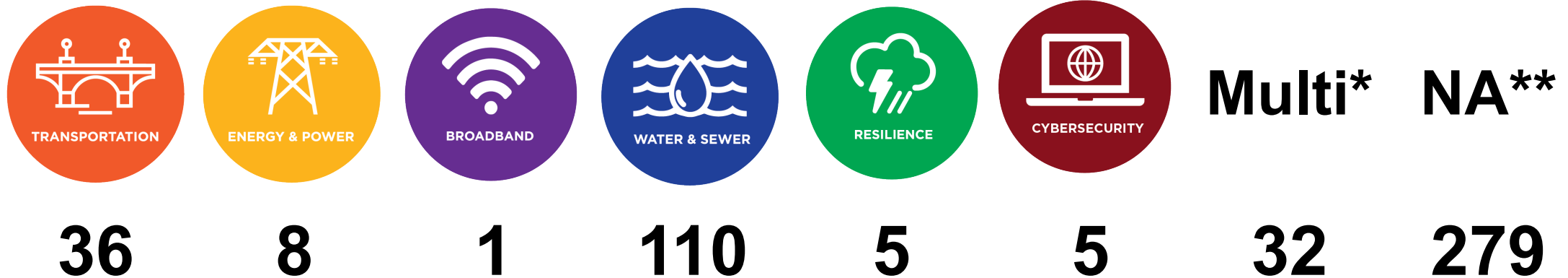

\*\*NA – Applications included projects that are NOT BIL eligible, such as housing, interior aesthetic building renovations, and other programs such as childcare.

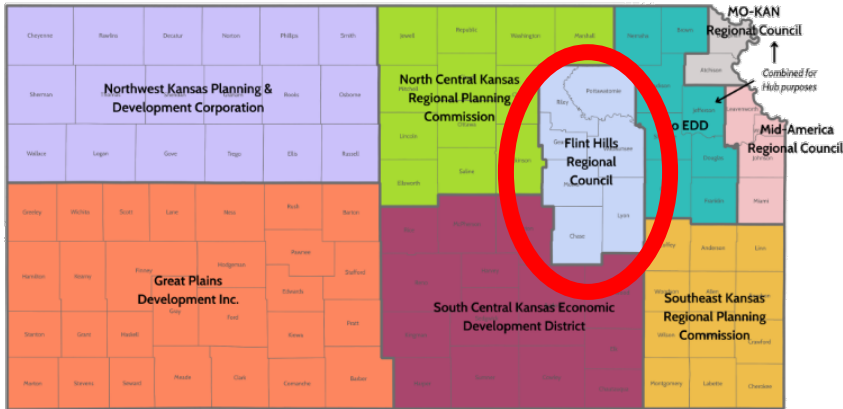


# BASE to BIL | Next Steps

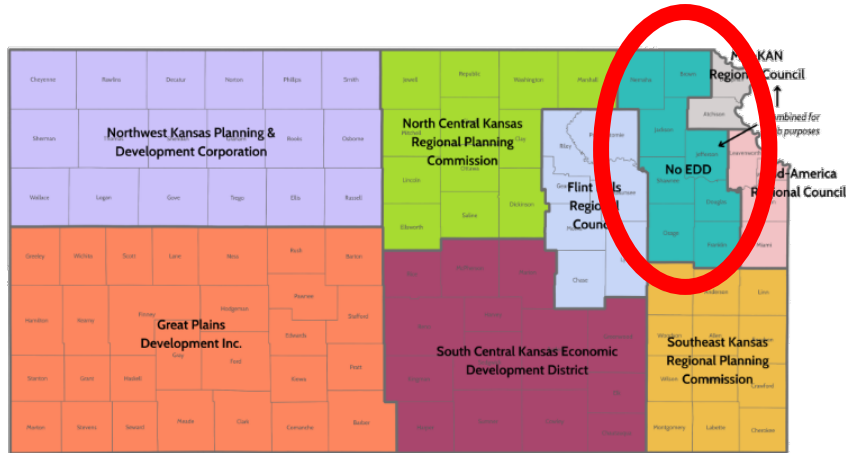

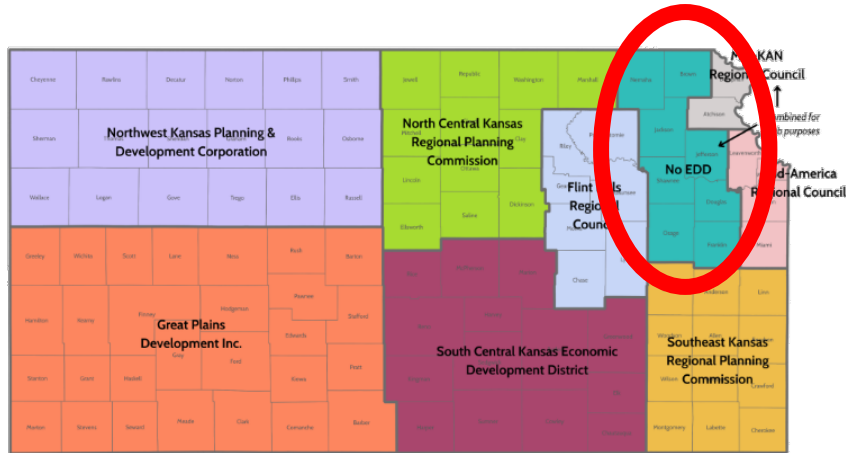

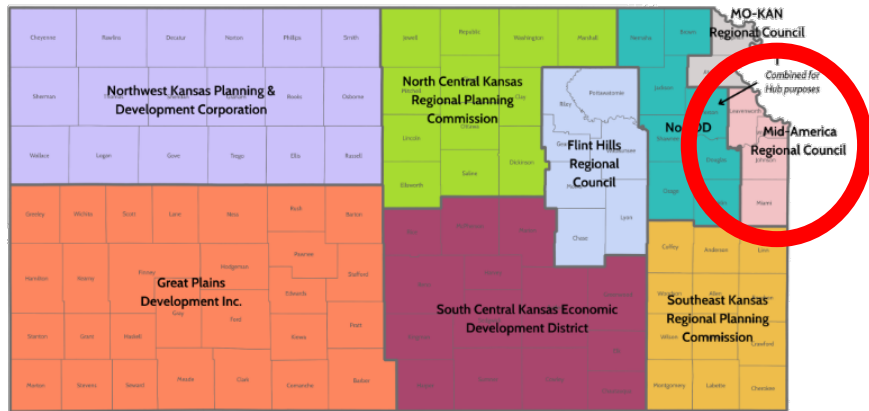
